3.1 Ingredients

None of the ingredients is currently classified as hazardous according to Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008. The products are comprised mainly of oligofructose /inulin and small amounts of natural sugars such as fructose, glucose and sucrose.

Inulin has no known negative environmental effects. Because inulin is a natural polysaccharide, it is easily biologically degradable.

The components are not considered persistent or bioaccumulative, nor are they considered toxic. Given a significant water solubility the components are expected to be mobile in sediment and soil.

SECTION 13: Disposal considerations

Remove in accordance with local rules and regulations. In general dry material can be put on a dumping ground. Wet material can be disposed by the sewer, if diluted, to prevent blockage.
